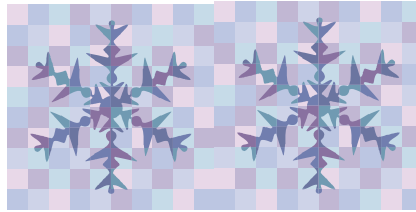


A POEM WRITTEN BY REDWOOD – YEAR 3
